Republic Day Celebrations at ECIL

Maj. Gen. (retd.) Sanjeev Loomba, Acting CMD, expressed satisfaction on ECIL's achievements in the recent past, such as 32 metre Antenna for India's moon mission, Integrated Security Solutions for Commonwealth Games, Biometric enrolment for National Population Register (NPR), Digital Data Capture for Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC), a 10Gbps link successfully established between Mumbai and Pune with ECIL's routers. He also stated that ECIL is proud to have introduced new indigenous products like the PROGICON Series PLCs (Programmable Logic Controllers), ECR Transport Routers, Machinery Protection Systems, Network Security products i.e. Secure Network Access System (SNAS) and Integrated Threat Management Appliance (ITMA). ECIL is rediscovering its roots with Strategic Self Reliance and IP developed within the company. He exhorted ECIL employees to rekindle the spirit of self- enquiry.
