### **Republic Day Celebrations at ECIL**

**Electronics Corporation of India Limited (ECIL)**, the torchbearer of Indian electronics, celebrated the 62nd Republic Day with gaiety and enthusiasm. Shri Y S Mayya, Chairman & Managing Director, hoisted the national flag at the ceremonial function held at the factory main gate and inspected the Guard of Honour presented by a Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) contingent.

Among the dignitaries who participated in the function were Maj. Gen Sanjeev Loomba - Director (Personnel), Shri N S S Prasada Rao - Director (Technical), Shri Shiv Kumar Nori - Director (Finance), Shri BVVSSN Prasad, President - ECIL Officers' Association and Shri G Yadava Reddy, President - ECIL Employees Union.

Shri Mayya expressed satisfaction about ECIL's achievements in the recent past which included the highly successful Integrated Security System for Commonwealth Games 2010 at N.Delhi. ECIL is also involved in a complex defence Communications Intelligence (COMINT) System which is nearing completion, Control and Instrumentation System for India's first Prototype Fast Breeder Reactor, Propulsion System for Underwater Vehicles and participation in high technology projects like ITER - an international project to design and build an experimental fusion reactor, FAIR - Facility for Antiproton and Ion Research, 32 meter Deep Space Network Antenna for Chandrayaan, MACE Telescope - Major Atmospheric Cerenkov Telescope Experiment (the biggest telescope of its kind) etc.

He also spoke about ECIL's Vision 2020 which will propel ECIL to higher levels of growth especially in the Nuclear and Defence sectors, as by the end of the decade, a dozen new Nuclear reactors will be coming up and the Akash missile programme has entered into the mass production phase.

A colourful cultural programme which included dances and patriotic songs was presented by the students of Atomic Energy Central School - 1 on this occasion.
